The conference theme “Theory and Evidence in European Educational Research” will provide a focus for the keynote addresses, for other invited events as the EERJ Roundtable and may also be taken as a reference within the conference sessions organised by the EERA networks.

However, proposals for contributions are welcome from all fields of educational research. Participants are invited to hand in up to two abstracts for papers, posters, workshops, round tables and symposia. All proposals must be handed in electronically via the online submission form. Ph.D. students and New Researchers are especially invited to participate in the Pre-conference.
