# ECER 2024, Nicosia, VETNET Minutes Network Meeting, 29 August 2024

Approx. 25 researchers attended the meeting.

### Agenda

#### 1. Welcome and introduction

VETNET participants were welcomed and informed about VETNET's aims and regulations.

#### 2. ECER Nicosia

The link convenors thanked the programme committee responsible for setting up the programme, providing feedback to authors, and editing the proceeding. They informed the network about the number of submissions, accepted/rejected proposals for VETNET, and contributions to this year's VETNET proceedings. The quality of submissions and papers in the proceedings is high. The number of submissions was significantly lower than for ECER Glasgow (approx. 70 compared to more than 100 in Glasgow), and there were several withdrawals at short notice.

### 3. Elections

At ECER 2024, there were no elections.

Members were invited to apply to stand for elections on the board as of 2025. The procedure was outlined, and it was stressed that board members must apply in advance, be nominated by other members, and show how they will contribute to VETNET activities.

### 4. VETNET members and reviewers

The convenor thanked all colleagues who were reviewing for VETNET and invited members to become reviewers.

# 5. VETNET activities

The members discussed current and future VETNET activities, including EERN-VETNET, VETNET's newly established emerging researchers network chaired by Junmin Li and Susanne Peters. They exchanged ideas on how to promote and support young researchers' contributions to VETNET and the VETNET conferences.

Researchers were invited to contribute to one of the upcoming conferences, ECER 2025 in Belgrad, Crossing Boundaries in May 2025 in Palma, Stockholm International in Mai 2026, NordYrk 2025. They were encouraged to submit manuscripts to be published in IJRVET, NJVET, VETNET ECER Proceedings, Crossing Boundaries Proceedings, and the Stockholm International Book Series.
