

NETWORK MEETING - EERA Curriculum network (NW 3) --- minutes

Thursday September 2, 2022, 13:00-14:30 CEST

1. Welcome, how did you perceive ECER2022?

In-person ECER in Yerevan + ECER Plus (online version)

Both turned out to be a highly valued and well-attended activities. A working title for the season school/seminar might be "Theory as a lens for looking at curriculum".
