There were many first-time attendees, we had a very supportive community, easy to reach out to people especially during the sessions of NW7, sharing contacts and feedback was easy, having sub-focus (i.e. refugee education) is very valuable, the infrastructure of the university was very good also the coffee breaks. Having sessions at the same building was good.

4) What, if anything, did you dislike about this event?

The keynotes might have been hard for people with disabilities to attend, there were no sub-titles on the screen or on YouTube, no sign language interpretation.

A conference on inclusion should be inclusive.

The conference cost a lot and no lunch is provided.

Workshops got overbooked very quickly.

There were not enough volunteers, (when you find them, they were very helpful though), practical information (i.e. QR Code for help) was available but people were not informed about where to find this info.

Conference – app not user friendly and not inclusive because there is no screen reader.

5) Do you have any other suggestions or feedback you would like to share?

- accommodations in Nicosia will be expensive due to high season of tourism
- local organization committee should book affordable accommodation
- keynotes should be subtitled and interpreted for people with hearing disabilities
- the APP should have more filters for the search function
