



# **ECER2019**

Pecha Kucha	Lightning Talk	Ignite Talk	Speed Geeking
20 slides (more visual than text-laden), 20 seconds each	Slides are generally discouraged	20 slides with each slide advancing automatically after 15 seconds	Each presenter is stationed at a table (or flip chart with pens) around the room
Should be completed in less than 7 minutes	Typically lasts no more than five minutes	By design no longer than 5 minutes	Presenters usually have 5 minutes to give their presentation and answer questions
A Pecha Kucha presentation utilizes imagery and efficient use of spoken word to create a seamless, memorable, meaningful and concise presentation	These concise and efficient talks are intended to grab the attention of the audience and convey key information	The goal of ignite talks is to articulate a topic in a quick, insightful, and clear manner	Speed Geeking (similar to Speed Dating) is a large group method to quickly expose participants to new information about any topic. Ideally there are about 6-7 audience members for each presenter. At the end of the five minutes, each group moves over to the presenter to their right and the timer starts once more
A typical PechaKucha Night (PKN) includes 8 to 14 presentations	Several lightning talks will usually be delivered by different speakers in a single session (called a data blitz)	Ignite events usually have a dozen or more speakers
