Minutes of the Network 10. Teacher Education Research Network Meeting at ECER 2025

Our meeting agenda included six items, though we only had time to address three:

1. **Network Themes** The current network themes are:

Challenges of the European dimension in teacher education research

Research on pedagogical approaches in teacher education

Research on professional knowledge, identity, beliefs & understanding of teaching & learning in teacher education

Building a research-based agenda for teacher education

Research on teacher induction

Research on the theoretical base for teacher education

Now is the time to add relevant items. The suggestions we have received thus far are adding 'Teacher motivation and identity' and 'ICT and teacher education'. If you have additional themes in mind or prefer alternative titles for the existing ones, please let us know.

- **2. Reviewers Needed** We need more reviewers to help the network maintain the high quality of its presentations as well as its inclusive atmosphere. We thank the meeting participants who volunteered and ask those willing to take part in this important task to send us an email.
- **3.** Al in Teacher Education We had a brief discussion about the pros and cons of using Al in teacher education. The general consensus was that we cannot expect student teachers to refrain from using it. However, it remains unclear how to make students aware of the inaccuracies and low quality of work that Al often produces, and how to enhance critical thinking and monitoring of Al outcomes. Given Al's capabilities, we need to clarify what we still need our students to be able to do independently and why, as well as what high-quality scholarly work will look like in the future.
