

Network 10 meeting 2024, Nicosia

The network meeting brought together a small group of participants from many different countries. A couple of them were participating for the first time while others were well acquainted with the network. The meeting mainly consisted of two parts, an introductory information part and a discussion part. Information was given about the network in general and about two current opportunities for research. Through Susann Hofbauer and Marita Cronqvist, the network has been able to participate in testing a topic model application, EduTopic, which was developed by Alexander Christ, Jens Röschlein and Christoph Schindler from the DIPF, Leibniz Institute for Research and Information in Education. Through the application, everyone gets free access to all conference contributions within ECER since 25 years ago, which opens up new exciting research. We also informed about a special call in Zeitschrift für Bildungsforschung. See attached powerpoint for link and QR code. Since there weren't that many of us, we started the discussion part with a short round of presentations. We asked for suggestions via a padlet and got several ideas for joint sessions with other networks. Other suggestions were about possibilities for contacts within the network, more information on the web and workshops/meetings between the conferences. We also received comments that network meetings during lunch can be problematic and affect the opportunities to participate, not least this year.
