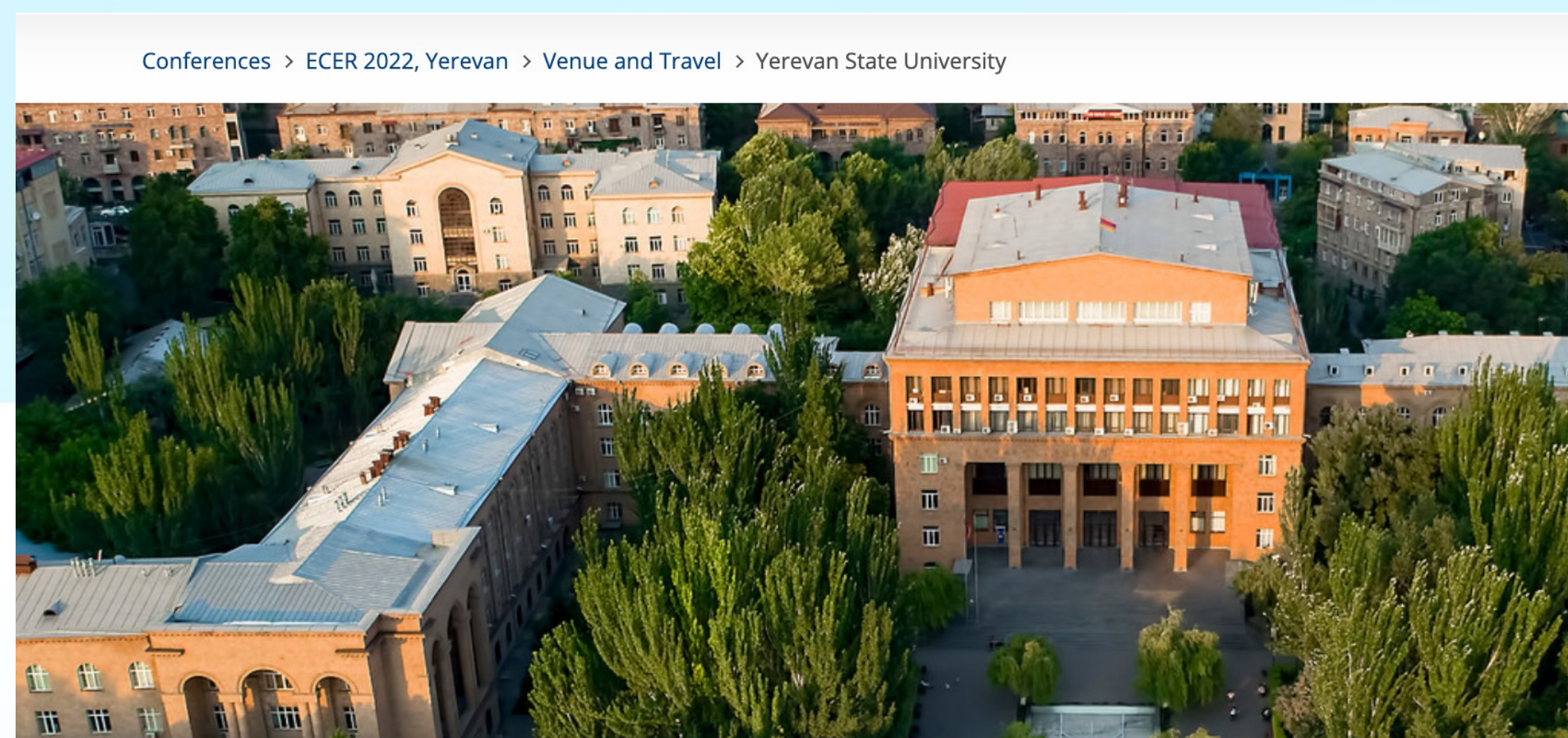



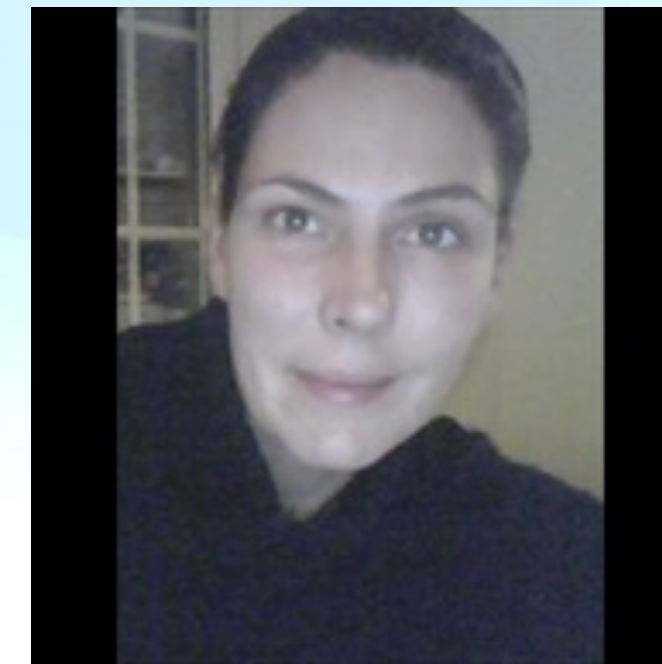

Election of new convenors

The main responsibilities of the convenors are:

- to maintain contact with the EERA office
- to communicate with network members and organize nw meetings
- to invite/ coordinate ECER contributions
- to review ECER proposals, find reviewers, put the program together
- to organize network activities, e. g. symposia, roundtables, workshops

Election Procedure:

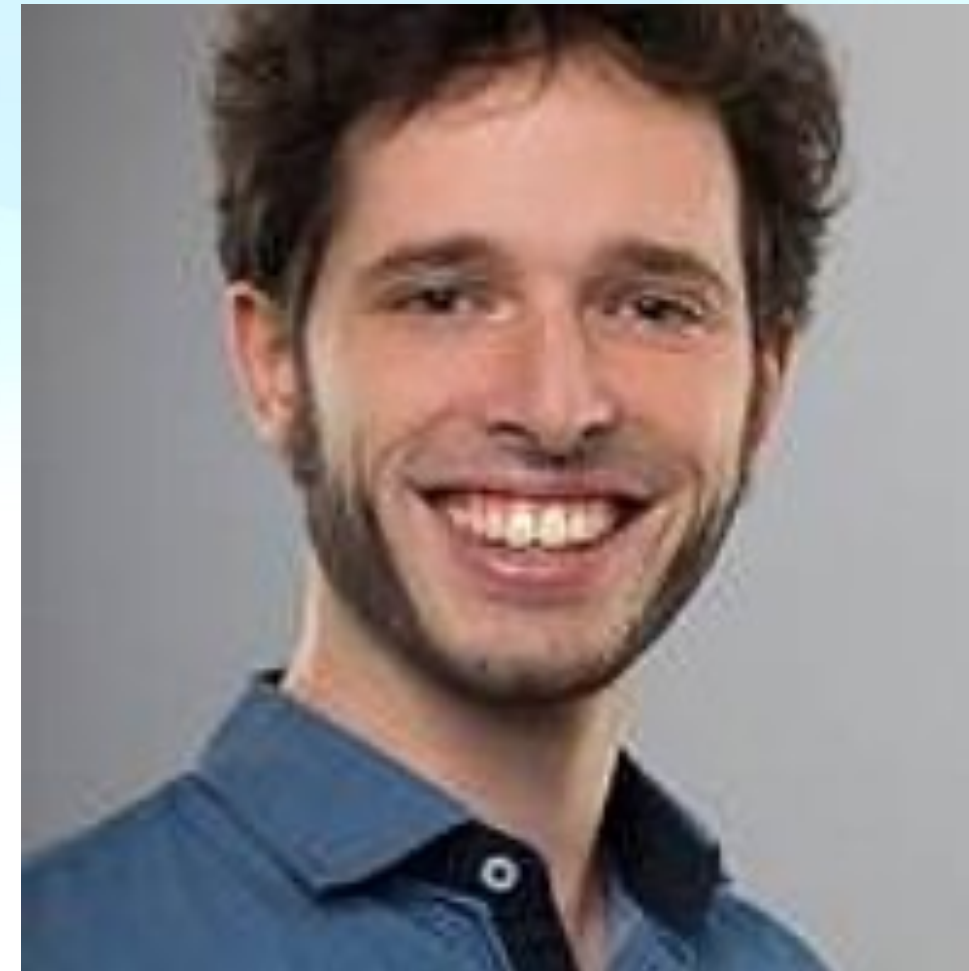
