


- Ca. 30 submissions originally (6 withdrawn after reviewing)

We want the ethnography network to be:

- a place that opens possibilities for thinking differently about people's lives, actions, and experiences
- challenging common-sense conceptions of educational processes, policies, and outcomes
- a platform for ethnographic debates and a meeting point for various styles of attending to "what is going on"
- a safe space that suspends local power regimes to recollect how and why we are doing educational ethnography – for those who metaphorically (or literally) wish to dance their data

- Learning about different cultures of doing ethnography
- Getting feedback from outside your bubble
- Sharing resources, exploring funding opportunities
- Making your research seen on a European scale
- → We want you to think about the ethnography network as your platform and space: Organise symposia, workshops, summer schools, zoom sessions, ...






