


## NW 20. RESEARCH IN INNOVATIVE INTERCULTURAL LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

The details are the following: Deadline: November, 3, 2023, Max 500 words, Title, Times New Roman 12, space line 1,5, and justified. Selection: end of January
