III. Special sessions

 Joint Sessions: In ECER 2023 NW29 participated in 4 Joint Sessions. One with NW33. Gender and Education, and 3 with NW 13.
 Philosophy of Education.

- **Special Calls:** In ECER 2023 NW29 has carried out 4 sessions from 2 Special Calls:
 - 1 session about *Transdisciplinary among arts: sharing projects in which artistic disciplines are entangled*

- 3 sessions about : Arts and democracy: how artistic research and arts based research can help to shape and rethink conceptions of democracy

- 1. Launching 2 Special Calls for ECER 2024:
- Care in Arts-Education Research
- The Materiality in Arts-Education Research
- 2. Round table or Symposium for ECER 2024 about The use of Visual and Artistic methods in Educational Research.

IV. Season School in Finland (Aalto University) (2023, 2024)

Between 5-8 June 2023 the NW29 - Spring School was carried out in Finland, organized by Mira Kallio-Tavin and Anniina Suominen. 10 PhD students and 5 mentors participated.

We think it is a very interesting experience in which students and mentors cohabitate during a week and through different workshops and meetings students can share their research and go further in their advancements.

It is expected to organize another one in Finland as well from 3-6 June 2024. More details will be sent soon.
