Introducing the history of Network 31 – we've come far as a group.

Thanks to Convenors, Reviewers, Network members and supporters for all their hard work this year. Special thanks to session chairs – planned and unplanned (!). Symposium organisers, schedulers, also.

This year, we've had a smooth review process throughout – well done, all ☺. We're still working with the double-blind reviewing process, which continues to be robust. 3<sup>rd</sup> reviewer for 'difficult' abstracts. 118 submitted; 108 accepted.

The 'European dimension' in the reviewing process – <u>Hanne's comment</u>. Unclear what the European perspective is. What is the allocation in the review scoring system – what are the elements that make up this criterion? There have been inconsistent application/allocation of scores in the past. Can reviewers come together to agree what this criterion means – in practical terms for reviewers. To ensure consistency. Hanne kindly agreed to write up a guidance note on this for reviewers.

There are **42 Reviewers** in NW 31 this year. Reviewers there is no pressure to do any more than you feel able to - let us know how many you can or can't do, so the right number of abstracts can be allocated. Email Irina early if you've been allocated too many – they can easily be reallocated.

## **Network Activity** in 2019:

Lunch with emerging researchers at ERC. Workshop on multilingual assessment. We have plans for further work.

We want to access **more EERA funding**. To support network-related research. E.g. network projects, Network Season schools. Network related publications.

Other innovations for the next year:

• Peer-mentoring programme in Network 31. Peer to peer support. Needs volunteers from Network members. EERA will be funding – workshops, meetings and seminars.
