

### May I resubmit the same proposal I submitted to ECER 2020 to ECER 2021?

Yes. You are welcome to resubmit last year's proposal to ECER 2021, however we would like to strongly recommend that you update your proposal to reflect the most recent research. Submissions which were accepted to the cancelled ECER 2020 will NOT automatically be accepted to ECER 2021. All submissions will be subject to review by this year's programme committee.

### How do I resubmit the same proposal I submitted to ECER 2020 to ECER 2021?

Important: In order to indicate that your proposal was already reviewed in 2020, please include LAST YEAR'S paper ID number in the title of your submission in the following format, *including the parentheses/brackets*:  
(2020ID: paper ID number).

In order to facilitate this process, we have added this prefix to the title in conftool 2020.

Before the programme is published we will automatically update all titles by removing the ID reference. As this will be done automatically by the Conftool system, it is essential that you enter LAST YEAR'S Paper ID in the exact format requested, including the brackets. **You can see an example of this below.**

### Where do I find last year's submission title with the added prefix?

You will find last year's submission title with the added prefix in the ECER 2020 Conftool system, to which you still have reading access

- click on "Your Submissions"
- you will see the title with the prefix. Copy it in its entirety, *including the parentheses/brackets*, to use as the title when you resubmit this proposal to ECER 2021.
